TEACHING POINT

The month of August is traditionally dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The physical heart of Mary is venerated (and not adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love (especially for her divine Son), virtue, and inner life. Such devotion is an incentive to a similar love and virtue. This devotion received new emphasis from the visions given to Lucy Dos Santos, oldest of the visionaries of Fatima in Spain, in 1925 and 1926. In the visions Our Lady asked for the practice of the Five First Saturdays to help make amends for the offenses committed against her heart by the blasphemies and ingratitude of men. The practice parallels the devotion of the Nine First Fridays in honour of the Sacred Heart. On 31stOctober 1942, Pope Pius XII made a solemn Act of Consecration of the Church and the whole world to the Immaculate Heart.

FORTHCOMING COMMEMORATION

Of Europe's six patron saints, one was added by Pope St Paul VI (Saint Benedict), and the other five co-patrons were added by Pope St John Paul II (Saint Bridget of Sweden, Saint Catherine of Siena, Saint Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein) and Saints Cyril & Methodius). Each of these six of these patrons has an incredible story of how they responded to God's call in their life, a call which had a significant impact on the Church.
