The purpose of the World Day of Prayer for Vocations is to publically fulfil the Lord's instruction to, 'Pray the Lord of the harvest to send labourers into his harvest' (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2). While appreciating all vocations, the Church concentrates its attention this day on vocations to the ordained ministries (priesthood and diaconate), to the Religious life in all its forms (male and female, contemplative and apostolic), to societies of apostolic life, to secular institutes in their diversity of services and membership, and to the missionary life, in the particular sense of mission 'ad gentes' (to the nations). 2023 marks the 60th anniversary of this event.
