TODAY'S COMMEMORATION

The fifty days of the sacred season of Easter conclude with Pentecost Sunday, when the Universal Church recalls the gift of the Holy Spirit to the Apostles, the beginnings of the Church, and the start of her mission to all tongues and peoples and nations. After Pentecost Sunday the Easter candle is kept in the baptistery, so that from its flame the candles of the baptised may be lit during their baptism. At funerals the Easter candle is placed near the bier, to signify that Christian death is a true Passover.

PAPAL REPRESENTATIVE

At a Mass to welcome the new Apostolic Nuncio to Great Britain, Cardinal Vincent Nichols described the Catholics of England and Wales as "a faithful people" with a "depth of faith in our history and in our hearts." The text of his homily is on the noticeboard and the Bishopric website.

RELIGIOUS ART

St Francis of Assisi is the inspiration for the latest exhibition at the National Gallery. Canonised in 1228, two years after his death in 1226, there are more depictions of Francis than any other non-Biblical saint.
