TODAY'S COMMEMORATION

The theme for the 57th World Communications Day is: Speaking with the heart. "The truth in love" (Eph 4:15). The Pope hails the example of the great Doctor of the Church, St Francis de Sales, and his commitment to patient, heartfelt dialogue with everyone – even those who opposed him. A gifted theologian, his phrase "Heart speaks to heart" inspired many, none more so than the recently canonised Saint John Henry Newman who, on being made a Cardinal in 1879 by Pope Leo XIII, chose as his cardinalatial motto, *Cor ad cor loquitur*. 'Heart speaks unto heart' was also the motto for Pope Benedict XVI's historic visit to the UK in 2010. The full text of the Pope's message may be found on the noticeboard and the Bishopric website.

The Prime Minister's Special Envoy for Freedom of Religion or Belief will receive a petition calling for justice on behalf of victims of a massacre carried out at a packed church in Nigeria. The petition, organised by Catholic charity Aid to the Church in Need (ACN), will be handed in to Fiona Bruce MP on 5th June, the first anniversary of the attack at St Francis Xavier's Church in Owo, south-west Nigeria.
