UNIVERSAL GATHERING

Hundreds of thousands of young people from many parts of the world will be heading for Lisbon to celebrate World Youth Day (WYD) from tomorrow, Monday, 31st July. Pope Francis will join them there from the 2nd to 6th August. The motto chosen by the pope for this day is taken from Luke's Gospel: "Mary arose and went with haste" (Lk 1:39): hastening to prepare for the journey to Lisbon is what the young people will be doing too. TEACHING POINT

On 2nd August, or another day determined by the Ordinary for the convenience of the people, the plenary indulgence traditionally called the "Portiuncula" indulgence may be acquired in minor basilicas, shrines and parish churches. The practices prescribed for the obtaining of the indulgence are a devout visit to a church and the recitation there of the Lord's Prayer and the Creed and in addition a sacramental confession, Holy Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff. This indulgence may be acquired only once. The visit may be made from noon the previous day until midnight of the day itself. (Enchiridion of Indulgences, concession 33)

SCRIPTURAL PROCLAMATION

The Dicastery for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments has confirmed the approval by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales for the new Lectionary. The Lectionary, which includes the scripture readings for Mass and the sacraments, will come into use in Catholic parishes in England and Wales from Advent 2024.
