PAPAL PROCLAMATION

Pope Francis has inaugurated a Year of Prayer ahead of the 2025 Jubilee, calling on the faithful "to intensify prayer to prepare us to live well this event of grace and to experience the power of God's hope." In remarks after the Angelus recently, the Holy Father explained that the Year of Prayer is dedicated "to rediscovering the great value and absolute need for prayer, prayer in personal life, in the life of the Church, prayer in the world." He added that the Dicastery for Evangelization will be preparing materials to assist in celebrating the Year. 2025 will also be the 1700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea (325 AD).
