COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

PAPAL COMMUNICATION

In his first General Audience after a summer break the Pope Francis took up the theme of the Holy Spirit in the Incarnation of the Word, beginning with the affirmation of the Creed that Jesus "by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man." The full text is available on the noticeboard and the Bishopric website.

HOLY OBLIGATION

The Catholic Church teaches as dogma that the Virgin Mary "having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory". This doctrine was dogmatically defined by Pope Pius XII on 1 November 1950, in the apostolic constitution Munificentissimus Deus by exercising papal infallibility. Item 39 points to the Book of Genesis (3:15) as scriptural support for the dogma in terms of Mary's victory over sin and death as also reflected in 1 Corinthians 15:54: "then shall come to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory".

CONFLICT CASUALTY
