Last Wednesday Archbishop Gabriele Caccia, Permanent Observer of the Holy See to the United Nations, delivered a statement at the 11th Emergency Special Session of the General Assembly, which addressed the territorial integrity of Ukraine. In his remarks he repeated the heartfelt plea of Pope Francis to end the conflict, pointing out that, with every ongoing hour, innocent lives are lost and the wounds among peoples are deepened.
