## **SPIRITUAL GATHERING**

Archbishop Paul Gallagher, Vatican Secretary for Relations with States, celebrated Mass for Ambassadors to the Holy See in Rome last week to pray for the Pope. His homily noted the Holy Father's gratitude "for the closeness and the prayer that rises abundantly to Heaven for him". This followed an health update stating that: "The Holy Father's clinical condition is confirmed to be improving. The Holy Father has suspended non-invasive mechanical ventilation and also has less need of high-flow oxygen therapy. Motor and respiratory physiotherapy is continuing to make progress".
